QUICK GUIDE 2022

Beginning in October 2022, the Knoxville Community Dashboard on Homelessness has a new look – and a lot of new features!

This all-new dashboard includes:

- 1) **...The first-ever interactive *Annual Report*.** To toggle between the most recent **quarterly** numbers and the 2021 **Annual Report**, click "" in the top right of the Dashboard. Beyond the numbers themselves, [Here's a detailed addendum](#) to this 2021 Annual Report.
- 2) **...Counts as daily averages.** See the link above for why that's important.
- 3) **...Nearly twenty new graphs.** For the first time, check the map to see where our KnoxHMIS neighbors are from, track trends over time in self-reported causes for homelessness, and review disabilities, demographics, and housing outcomes
- 4) **...Filters by subpopulation!** Click wherever you see "" to track the associated data points for selected groups (Veterans, Seniors, Black, White, and more)

A couple of quick tips:

- **HOVER** is your friend: Hover your cursor over many parts of this dashboard for additional data or explanations
- As noted above, select from **DROP-DOWN MENUS** to parse the data by subpopulation, change bed utilization by project types, and toggle between the most recent YEAR or QUARTER
